

WEEKEND ONE (Oct. 6-9) - is the in-person weekend of the festival. This will be the first PofA Festival hosted in NYC since 1939! The first day of the festival will allow registrants to visit a myriad of puppet destinations throughout NYC, while the majority of the festival will be held at Coney Island USA (CIUSA is a 40 year-old arts non-profit and venue in South Brooklyn just two blocks from the boardwalk and the beach. It is home to the Coney Island Circus Sideshow, Burlesque at the Beach, the world-famous Mermaid Parade, the Coney Island Film Festival, Puppets Come Home!, the Coney Island Museum, and so much more! - www.coneyisland.com). The focus will be on puppet history in Coney Island, and puppetry as practiced in NYC and the Northeast/Mid-Atlantic regions. You will need to be physically present in Brooklyn, NY (specifically Coney Island) on October 6-9, in order to participate. We will not be providing any housing, but please find the link regarding local accommodations. This is the most current version of the Weekend One festival schedule. Additions will be made as the festival date approaches.
